
Missing Credits?

Requesting Transcripts

- Transcript request form
- Will be mailed within 2 weeks
- Attach any counselor forms.
 - Complete Student Section--don't forget to put your name on them!

A Few College Quirks

- Most schools look for a MINIMUM of two years of foreign language
- Change of Senior Schedule:

Notify colleges of core class changes after you have applied and/or been admitted

The Application Process

You are responsible for:

- Application & Fee
- Essays (if required)
- Having ACT/SAT scores sent to colleges
- Requesting Teacher(s) to complete recommendation letter (provide a stamped, addressed envelope)
- Requesting a transcript, midyear report and final transcript as needed
- Verifying that all information, including transcript, arrived at the admissions office

The Application Process

MSSPA is responsible for:

• Sending requested transcripts within 10 school days of request date
